AUTOMATED STORAGE & RETRIEVAL SYSTEM(AS/RS)



Unit-Load AS/RS

Unit-load AS/RS systems are typically used to handle large and heavy loads ranging from 1,000 to 5,500 pounds.



Mini-Load AS/RS

Mini-Load AS/RS is ideal for handling smaller items, usually weighing no more than 75 pounds.



Shuttle AS/RS

Shuttle AS/RS transports items horizontally and vertically in warehouses/workspaces via shuttles along tracks between different areas.



AMR Autonomous Mobile Robots AS/RS

An autonomous mobile robot (AMR) uses independent robots to navigate the racking, using multiple pathways to retrieve items for a specified tote or location.
